

Launching Venus 1500 v4

In order to use a program, you must start—or launch—it first.

Desktop

1. Look for the orange **V icon shortcut** on your desktop. (Fig. 1)
2. Double click the shortcut.
3. The **Venus 1500** window appears.


Windows XP, Vista or 7 Start Menu

1. Click the Windows **Start** button.
The Start menu appears.
2. Point to **All Programs or Programs**.
A menu appears. The programs and menus listed here will depend on the programs installed on your computer.
4. Point to **Daktronics**.

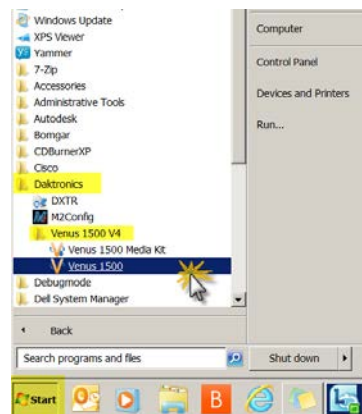


Figure 2: Launching Venus 1500 from the All Programs or Programs menu in Windows XP, Vista or 7.

5. Point to **Venus 1500 V4**. (Fig. 2)
6. Click **Venus 1500**.

The Venus 1500 V4 program screen appears.

- ✓ **Tip:** If you use Venus 1500 frequently, you might consider pinning it to the Start menu. To do this, right-click **Venus 1500** in the Programs or All Programs menu and select **Pin to Start Menu** from the contextual menu.

Windows 8 Start Screen

1. Open Start by swiping in from the right edge of the screen (or if you're using a mouse, pointing to the upper-right corner of the screen and moving the mouse point down,) and then tapping or clicking **Start**
✓ **Tip:** You can also use the Windows key  on your keyboard to go to Start.
2. Browse the Windows **Start Screen**.
3. Click the **Venus 1500 icon**. (Fig 3)
The **Venus 1500** program screen appears.
